Second phase:

- Installation of digital slide scanner for telepathology.

Third phase:

- Full restoration of the histopathology laboratory.
- Anatomopathological diagnostic activities through telepathology.

RENOVATIONS OF DENTAL CLINIC



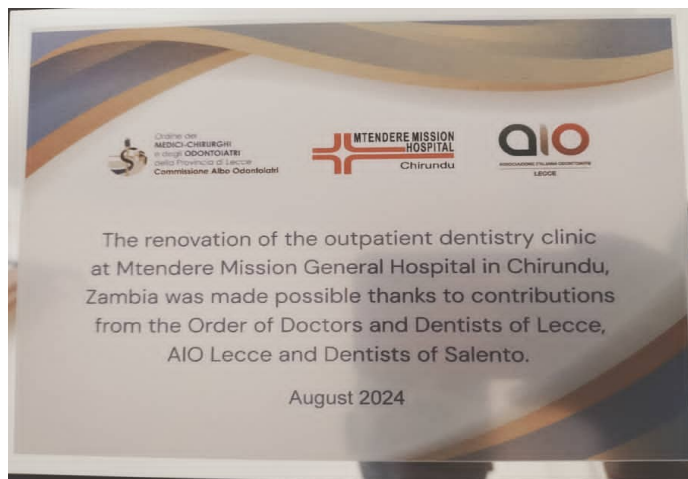
